- Mobile library Similar to the mobile library van
- Book Depot or Deposit Station Colocation of library in a council office, community centre, shop or another facility. Generally staffed by volunteers. Access to catalogue. Book collection and materials are changed periodically.
- eResources Book collection and materials available over the internet
- Mail Delivery Service Regular deliveries of client requested library materials to clients homes or specified collection point
- Joint Use School Library A library is provided within the local school library e.g. Timboon.
- Library Kiosk Use of vending machines to access books (similar to food and drink vending machines)
- Nearest Library Accessing library branch close by:
- Pop-up library Generally located at a local facility, the pop up library brings the library to the people.
